



HACCP Refresher

Purpose

This course provides an introduction and refresher to the principles and applications of Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point systems (HACCP), based on the latest revisions adopted by the Codex Alimentarius Commission Food Hygiene Committee.

- List the potential hazards and sources of contamination.
- Identify the components of a documented and implemented HACCP system.
